In this meeting, they informed my staff that the Department of Homeland Security's Office of Inspector General has been unresponsive to them. They have made some serious allegations regarding the oversight of the NFIP, and I ask you to take appropriate action to address this matter.

The group also expressed their concern that there are still many flood victims from Hurricane Isabel, which struck North Carolina over a year ago, who have yet to have their claims resolved. Thank you for your attention. I look forward to your response.
